



## COVID-19 Visitor Guidelines

### PURPOSE:

To provide information regarding the policy as it relates to visitors on campus during COVID-19

### DEFINITION:

We look forward to welcoming visitors to the campus of Mary Baldwin University and the branch campus of the Murphy Deming College of Health Sciences. Your health and safety are our top priorities. Please be assured that MBU is following guidelines issued by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the Commonwealth of Virginia, and the Virginia Department of Health for increased health and safety procedures.

To continue to keep our campus safe, all visitors aged 12 and older must show proof that they have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine to visit our campus during indoor events. All visitors age 18 and older must also show a valid photo ID.

Proof of vaccination may include:

- CDC vaccination card (or photo of card)
- An official immunization record from outside of Virginia or the United States

Valid ID includes your name accompanied by a photograph OR your date of birth, such as:

- Driver's license
- Government ID card
- Passport
- School ID card

Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a vaccinated adult. Visitors who cannot display their proof of vaccination are welcome to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours of the event. The Covid Test may be a rapid test or a PCR. The test must be validated by a healthcare provider or testing center.

As a reminder, MBU students should show their campus ID at indoor events and do not need to show vaccination status or negative tests.

Face coverings are required for all visitors ages 2 and older, even if you are vaccinated. Please maintain physical distance from those not in your immediate party. If you are having any symptoms of illness, please refrain from coming to campus.

The health and safety of all is our priority. MBU will continue to monitor and abide by the guidelines issued by the CDC and our local department of health for health and safety procedures that inform our operations.

So that the university can continue to remain safe and openly welcome visitors to our campus, we ask that all persons abide by these policies.

### **Important Additional Guidelines**

- Please stay home if you are feeling sick.
- Help prevent the spread of germs by washing your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Hand sanitizer is also available throughout the campus.
- Face masks are required indoors at all times.
