As I look to the summit of our campus this week, I am reminded of the statement, "Bridges don't fall from the sky; we have to build them," written by Eboo Patel, Founder and President of Interfaith America.

American flags, both on Cannon Hill and across the state, are flying at half-staff to mourn the devastating loss of innocent lives in Israel and Gaza.

While highly complicated issues, historical contexts, and religious differences underscore the war that began in the Middle East this weekend, we unequivocally condemn the senseless and horrific acts of terrorism that started this war and have now led to the killing of innocent Israelis and Palestinians.
