DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED: A copy of the death certificate for each of your parents. If you are unable to provide these certificates, you cannot be considered independent for financial aid purposes.

Foster Care - you were in foster care at any time since the age of 13, even if you are no longer in foster care as of today.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED: A copy of the court orders, or a letter from your caseworker to verify your status. If you are unable to provide these certificates, you cannot be considered independent for financial aid purposes.

Ward of the Court - you are/were a dependent or ward of the court at any time since the age of 13, even if you are no longer a dependent or ward of the court as of today.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED: A copy of the court's decision, or any other documentation that can verify your status. If you are unable to provide these certificates, you cannot be considered independent for financial aid purposes.
